Many thanks for getting in touch.

If you are an organised club then yes the rule of 6 would be exempt for organised walks, allowing up to 30 (ensuring all guidance on risk assessment etc is followed)

Regarding local lockdown restrictions, you would need to look at what the specific restrictions are for that lockdown area by looking at the government website and the local authority too, as these can supersede the rule of 6 if they require it to.
